# Dear Parishioners:

A church provides the atmosphere for spiritual, social and physical support that is not available in other social organizations. When I reflect on my own church experience, I think of the those things that drew me to a church body and those things that keep me in the catholic priesthood:

## 1. FRIENDSHIP

Most of my life-long friends have developed through a connection to a church family. Whether it was people I knew through church as a child or friends I made belonging to various church activities – most of my current relationships are tied to that church anchor. Making and having friends that share the same beliefs and values help us all navigate this bizarre world we live in.

## 2. OPPORTUNITIES TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

One of the biggest benefits of church membership is its collective resource that provides opportunities to help others and make a difference. Church volunteer opportunities are available at most churches and these opportunities provide the system and structure to serve or support a cause. For example, our pantry provides food to those experiencing homelessness and provides the structure for Volunteers to get involved in helping other people. These kinds of experiences reinforce the Christian call to love and help other people. When we know we make a difference for a cause it gives us hope for a better world.

## 3. ACCOUNTABILITY

Belonging and being registered to a church provide a level of accountability for its members. Members that pledge to support our Archdiocesan and parish needs show to themselves and relatives how strong, deep and big is their faith. Of course, their weekly attendance makes them accountable by just showing up and being reminded of their core beliefs. The world offers many distractions and contradictions to Christian beliefs so having a community of people to interact with who think the same way helps to reinforce and hold us accountable to biblical principles. Committing to anything new can be a struggle. Like starting using a gym. It can be easy to drop off after a few weeks, but if you paid the whole year, it can help us to stay committed. So make your pledge and bring to mass your Sunday donation in the envelope provided for such. Having a process in place also makes it easier for church officials to communicate directly with them (think about how far a personal email asking them how their experience has been so far would go) and encourage those direct conversations with new members. This will help new members feel more engaged and likely to stick around longer.

## 4. SENSE OF COMMUNITY

Our fast paced culture has many of us living in isolation so much that we often live in neighborhoods and don't even know the people down the street. Belonging to a church body provides interactions with other people and creates a social community.

## 5. PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

As Christians we are all on a journey of personal, spiritual and ethical development. Whether we are new Christians or have been a Christian for a long time, a dynamic church can offer church leadership, discipleship and spiritual development and growth.

## 6. SOCIAL EVENTS

Whether it is participating in a bible-study, a prayer group, or coffee-hour and soup night... the opportunities are there to participate in church events with friends and other church members. We all have the responsibility of making St. Bernard a church community that new comers can call home and make life-long friends. I challenge you to step up and get involved in our parish groups and ministries. Find a ministry to get more involved and watch your life get transformed!
