Dear Parishioners...

The text of Deuteronomy, from the first reading, opens with a peremptory mandate: "Listen to the voice of the Lord, your God, keeping his precepts and commands, what is written in the code of the Law"; expression that sounds completely legalistic, but in the end, it is emphasized that this text of law refers to the heart of man; as if the legal text underwent a process of internalization; that is, it is not something imposed from the outside, but a word-invitation that challenges the human being from within and invites him to give a personal response. Whoever is not content with an arid register of duty to the Law, discovers the depth of an obedience that is born from the demand and dynamism of God's love.

Can man's response fulfill God's expectations and demands? What God commands, in the words of Moses, does not exceed the capacity of man, it is within our reach, since it is a mandate that resonates in the human heart, in his mind, in his entire being.

We speak of this law as God's project always open to the conscience of man; a project that goes beyond any legality and that is recreated in the interiority and in the depths of the human experience. How can the human being discover it, how can you discover God's very project?

If we go to the text of today's gospel, the text of the parable of the Good Samaritan, we can see that the content of God's loving plan is far from those who limit their search to exclusively "learned" knowledge, that is, who intends to define the exact concept of the "neighbor" and precisely determine the limits of love. Jesus only asks one thing of those who do this: transform your "knowing" into "doing", as simple as that. When knowledge, knowing, is not transformed into concrete love, it ceases to be significant. Our love should be a little more concrete.

Because there are those who, practicing each and every one of the precepts, are unable to love the "neighbor". This fact marks the difference between the Samaritan and the priest or the Levite. All three characters are able to see, but they don't respond in the same way. The fundamental difference is the response of someone who sees with the eyes of God, with the eyes of compassion and identifies with the pain of the other. May the Lord help us to look at the world around us and its people with all compassion and tenderness.

Estimada Tia Tota:

El texto del Deuteronomio, de la primera lectura, se abre con un mandato perentorio: "escucha la voz del Señor, tu Dios, guardando sus preceptos y mandatos, lo que está escrito en el código de la Ley"; expresión que suena del todo legalista, pero que al final, se subraya que este texto de ley hace referencia al corazón del hombre; como si el texto legal sufriera un proceso de interiorización; es decir, no es algo exterior impositivo, sino una palabra-invitación que interpela al ser humano desde dentro y le invita a dar una respuesta personal. Quien no se contenta con un árido registro del deber a la Ley, descubre la profundidad de una obediencia que nace de la exigencia y dinamismo del amor de Dios.

¿Puede la respuesta del hombre culminar las expectativas y exigencias de Dios? Lo que Dios manda, en palabras de Moisés, no excede la capacidad del hombre, está a nuestro alcance, ya que se trata de un mandato que resuena en el corazón humano, en su mente, en todo su ser.

Hablamos de esta ley como proyecto de Dios siempre abierto a la conciencia del hombre; un proyecto que supera cualquier legalidad y que se recrea en la interioridad y en lo más profundo de la experiencia humana. ¿Cómo el ser humano puede descubrirlo, cómo tú puedes descubrir el proyecto mismo de Dios?

Si acudimos al texto del evangelio de hoy, el texto de la parábola del buen Samaritano, podremos apreciar que el contenido del plan amoroso de Dios, dista mucho de quien limita su búsqueda a un conocimiento exclusivamente "docto" es decir, quien pretende definir el concepto exacto del "prójimo" y determinar con precisión los límites del amor. A quienes hacen eso, Jesús sólo les pide una cosa: transforma tu "saber" en "hacer", así de sencillo. Cuando el conocimiento, el saber, no se transforma en amor concreto, deja de ser significativo. Nuestro amor debería concretarse un poco más.

Porque hay quienes, practicando todos y cada uno de los preceptos, son incapaces de encontrarse con su "prójimo". Este echo marca la diferencia entre el samaritano y el sacerdote o el levita. Los tres personajes son capaces de ver, pero no responden de la misma manera. La diferencia fundamental es la respuesta de quien ve con los ojos de Dios, con los ojos de la compasión y se identifica con el dolor del otro. Que el Señor nos ayude a mirar el mundo que nos rodea y a las personas que lo conforman con toda compasión y ternura.

Did you know?


